

## Come to the Theatre

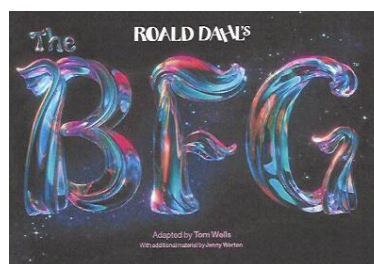
We are planning a backstage tour of the Chichester Festival Theatre for 2 April. This will cover some of the theatre's history and architectural design, but the focus is on how shows are put together, and the technical aspects. We will visit the dressing rooms, wardrobe department, scene dock, auditorium and also go on stage (set permitting).



The cost of the tour is £14 person and ideally we should not be more than 30, split into two groups. The tour starts at 10.30. We will meet at Shoreham Station and get the 9.27 train to arrive in Chichester at 10.03. At current prices it costs £10.30 with a senior railcard, £15.50 without one. We will arrange transport to Shoreham for those who need it, and others might want to do the whole journey by car.
